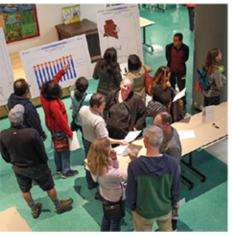

# How is Our School Development Plan Used?

- Guides ongoing assessment and review of goals and actions.
- Our school development plan is the driver for closing learning gaps and informs:
  - Instructional strategies
  - Professional learning
  - School structures and processes for learning
  - Resources to improve student learning
  - Data-informed decision making





# School Development Plan – School Goal

 To improve vocabulary development to support interpersonal skills and academic achievement



#### TIER 3

low-frequency words that are content specific

#### TIER 2

robust, high-frequency words that students encounter across the content areas and topics. Tier 2 words often have multiple meanings and are referred to as academic vocabulary words.

#### **TIER I**

basic, familiar words that are commonly used by most students in everyday conversation

# School Development Plan – Data for Monitoring Progress

- Students currently in grades 2-3 identified as 'requiring support' (at-risk) in the 'irregular words' category of the CC3
- Students in grades 1-3 identified as requiring support (atrisk) on the RAN, PAST, LeNs and CC3 assessments
- Students who identify as Indigenous in grades 1-5 who are scoring in the at-risk category for LeNS and CC3
- EAL students with overall LP level of 1 or 2 who require support (at-risk) on CC3 and LeNs
- Teacher perception data regarding vocabulary instruction





# **School Development Plan – Actions**

#### Learning Excellence

- Review new curriculum in ELAL and Mathematics to identify key vocabulary relevant to disciplinary knowledge and understanding
- Become familiar with various targeted approaches to teaching vocabulary development for elementary aged learners
- Review Tier 1 to Tier 3 vocabulary

#### Well-Being

- Create opportunities for cross-graded groupings to engage in literacy activities together
- Provide opportunities for flexible groupings for vocabulary instruction as needed
- Model inclusive language to avoid gender-specific pronouns when addressing large groups
- Explicitly teach vocabulary related to feelings, problem solving, inclusivity and regulation





# School Development Plan – Actions

- Truth & Reconciliation, Diversity and Inclusion
  - Explicitly teach and have students practice vocabulary related to the revised CBE Land Acknowledgement.
  - Provide targeted intervention to Indigenous students who are identified as at-risk in literacy, with an emphasis on early learning literacy skills
  - Provide differentiated instructional strategies to support neurodiverse students in language/vocabulary acquisition
  - Engage weekly in talking circles within every classroom community

- Our school received \$3,251,329.00 in 2024-25 to provide a quality education to our students and meet the goals in our school development plan (SDP).
- At Citadel Park School, approximately 93% of budgeted funds covers staffing and the remaining portion covers instructional and operational supplies.


